MOUNT BARKER CATTLE SALE 19/11/2020

Numbers were up for a total yarding of 2,286 head of good quality cattle at Mt Barker. A pen of light weight weaners steers topped at 500c and heifers at 440c/kg. Heavy cows remained firm at 286c and a heavy bull sold at 302c/kg.

Weaner steers weighing over 330kg sold from 375c to 444c while steers weighing between 280kg and 330kg made 418c to 446c and lighter weights were firm at 408c to 500c/kg. Weaner heifers weighing over 330kg making from 370c to 402c and lighter weights gained 15c selling at 340c to 440c /kg.

Yearling steers weighing over 400kg sold for 376c to 436c and lighter weights made from 386c to 422c /kg. Heavy yearling heifers sold from 345c to 348c while lighter weights returned 388c to 392c /kg.

Bullocks weighing over 600kg made 298c while grown steers weighing under 600kg made 298c to 350c and under 500kg weights sold for 348c to 386c/kg. Grown heifers weighing over 540kg made 318c to 342c while the lighter weights sold for 300c to 336c /kg.

Heavy prime cows were firm at 244c to 286c while the medium weight cows sold for 252c to 280c/kg. Store cows sold for 182c to 246c /kg.

Heavy bulls sold for 250c to 302c to processors, medium weight bulls made 300c while light weight bullys sold for 290c to 360c /kg.
