Market Comment:

A total yarding of 1,815 good quality weaners were offered for our first regular weaner sale for the year at Mt Barker. All categories finished up from last year with eastern states feedlots bidding keenly on heavy weight calves and feeder and background buyers vying for the lighter weights. Lightweight steers sold to a top of 498c and 458c for the heifers.

Weaner steers weighing over 380kg sold from 372c to 436c while steers weighing between 330kg and 380kg made 408c to 446c /kg. Lighter steers weighing 280kg to 330kg sold for 415c to 480c and weights from 200kg to 280kg returned 450c to 498c /kg.

Weaner heifers weighing over 380kg sold from 340c to 402c and weights from 330kg to 380kg made 330c to 416c/kg. Lighter weights between 280 to 330kg made from 380c to 444c and weights from 200kg to 280kg returned 386c to 458c /kg.

Weaner bulls sold to feeder buyers and live export from 250c to 442c depending on quality.
