

## **MT BARKER TRADE CATTLE SALE 08/01/2021**

A total yarding 350 head of mixed quality cattle were presented at Mt Barker for our first trade sale of the year. A quality line up of Trade cattle to processors gained in all categories topping at 388c/kg. Cows dominated the yarding selling to a top of 282c while heavy bulls sold to a top of 278c/kg.

Yearling steers sold from 386c to 418c while heifers made from 372c to 394c /kg.

Bullocks weighing over 600kg gained 7c selling for 280c to 388c while grown steers weighing under 600kg gained 19c returning 348c to 382c and under 500kg weights sold for 386c/kg. Grown heifers gained with weights over 540kg making 276c to 332c while the lighter weights sold for 290c to 362c /kg.

Heavy prime cows gained 5c on quality selling for 248c to 282c while the medium weight cows eased selling for 244c to 280c /kg. Boner cows made 166c to 244c and feeder buyers paid 180c to 258c averaging 226c/kg.

Heavy bulls eased selling for 220c to 278c while medium weight bulls made 254c to 282c /kg.
