## Market Comment:

A small offering at Muchea this week. Agents Yarded a total of 7476 head with Nutrien accounting for 3015 head of the total. The yarding was comprised of 5629 Lambs and 788 ewe mutton, quality lacked throughout the yarding in comparison to the previous few weeks however the market remains strong across the board.

The few heavy weight lambs sold at rates of \$190 to \$220 per head, Lambs in the trade weight category also sold at similar rates of \$165 to \$180 with the light trade strengthening, with the majority selling at \$150 to \$165 per head. The Airfreight / Feeder types strengthened to sell at rates of \$130 to \$155 with genuine stores selling dearer at \$70 to \$125 per head.

There were very few ewe mutton offered this week with the handful of heavy ewe mutton selling at similar rates of \$170 to \$200 per head, Genuine trade types sold at rates of \$140 to \$165 per head while light trade and boners sold rates of \$65 to \$130 per head.

There were a couple of drafts of good quality store wethers available, competition came from Agents and feeders with the majority selling dearer. Better store types sold at rates of \$135 to \$145 per head, lighter second drafts sold dearer at \$100 to \$130.
