Market Comment:

The Muchea offering this week had a total of 8349 head with Nutrien accounting for 3666 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 5452 Lambs, 208 sucker lambs and 1456 ewe mutton.

The heavy weight lambs sold at rates of \$180 to \$210 per head, to be slightly easier on the last few weeks

Lambs in the trade weight category also eased selling at rates of \$165 to \$175 with the light trade selling at \$150 to \$160 per head. The Airfreight / Feeder types remained similar to slightly easier on last week, most pens sold at rates of \$125 to \$140 per head with genuine stores selling for \$60 to \$115 per head.

There were some brilliant ewe mutton offered with eastern wheatbelt types leading the market selling at a high of \$239, the majority sold at \$170 to \$220 per head. Genuine trade types sold strong yet again at rates of \$145 to \$170 per head with light trade and boner mutton remaining similar on last week at rates of \$85 to \$130 per head.

There were several good lines of better store wether lambs attracting the attention of graziers and agents selling at \$125 to \$145 per head which was slightly easier on last week, lighter second drafts sold at rates of \$90 to \$110 per head down to a low of \$50 for very small frame lighter types.
