

MOUNT BARKER CATTLE SALE 09/09/2021

Numbers were up for a total yarding of 630 head of excellent quality cattle at Mt Barker. Prices gained on young cattle with demand for the quality angus line up offered. Light weight weaner steers sold to top of 610c while yearling steers sold to 546c /kg. An outstanding quality yarding of Angus heifers sold to 564c/kg.

Weaner steers sold from 490c to 610c while heifers sold from 460c to 564c depending on quality. Yearling steers sold from 400c to 554c while heifers returned 320c to 500c depending on quality.

Grown Steers weighing under 500kg made 380c to 488c while heavier 500kg to 600kg gained making 378c to 440c and over 600kg weights sold for 410c/kg. Grown heifers weighing under 540kg sold for 332c to 386c and heavier heifers sold for 355c to 396c/kg.

Heavy prime cows sold for 300c to 362c while medium weight cows returned 296c to 310c and store cows gained selling for 220c to 286c in a better-quality yarding.

Light weight bullies made 308c to 550c while prime heavy bulls eased 5c selling for 300c to 328c/kg.
