## Market Comment:

8367 head were offered this week at Muchea sheep sale with the majority of the yarding in store to light trade condition. Nutrien accounted for 1817 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised 3525 lambs, 3430 Ewe Mutton and the balance made up of predominately merino hoggets.

There were only a few good pens of trade suckers on offer which sold at rates of \$155 to \$195 per head to be similar to last week, Light Trade lambs sold at rates of \$135 to \$150 to finish firm, feeder and store lambs rebounded with stronger agent support with the majority selling at rates of \$110 to \$140 per head.

The mutton offered this week varied greatly in condition but saw good competition, Heavy trade types sold very similar and firm at rates of \$145 to \$170 with the genuine trades also similar selling at rates of \$115 to \$140 per head. Boner mutton sold at rates of \$88 to \$105 with very light boners to a low of \$70 per head finishing similar. selected lines of lighter younger mutton sold significantly stronger due to Agent competition pushing the trade buyers, those lines sold at rates of predominately \$115 to \$135
