Market Comment:

Numbers were up for a total yarding of 2,316 excellent quality weaners at Mt Barker. Weights were generally heavier with steers fluctuating with demand while heifers trended up on all categories. Restockers paid a top of 708c for light weight steers and 632c for heifers. Eastern states & local feedlots were again chasing heavy weight calves while the lighter weights went to local feed lotters, graziers, exporters and Angus heifers to eastern states restockers. Weaner steers weighing over 380kg sold from 438c to 596c while steers weighing between 330kg and 380kg made 500c to 616c /kg. Lighter steers weighing 280kg to 330kg sold for 555c to 648c and weights under 280kg returned 550c to 708c depending on quality.

Weaner heifers weighing over 380kg sold from 400c to 538c and weights from 330kg to 380kg made 490c to 562c/kg. Lighter weights between 280 to 330kg made from 478c to 608c and weights under 280kg returned 500c to 632c /kg. Weaner bulls sold to feeders and restockers from 342c to 470c /head.
