

MT BARKER CATTLE SALE 23/06/22

Yarding 228 head –down 197

Numbers eased for a small yarding of mainly good quality cattle. Weaner calves eased with steers topping at 640c and heifers at 570c/kg. Heavy bulls gained 4c selling to a top of 330c while heavy cows eased with demand selling to 318c/kg.

Heavy weight weaner steers over 330kg sold for 600c to 610c while medium weights made 602c to 638c and lightweight calves returned from 584c to 640c /kg. Heavy weight heifers made 520c to 558c, medium weights returned 542c to 570c and lightweights from 514c to 538c /kg. A small run of yearling steers sold for 600c and yearling heifers made from 348c to 576c depending on quality.

Grown steers made 420c to 450c to feeder buyers.

Heavy prime cows sold from 278c to 318c while store cows made 260c to processors & up to 370c for young cows to feeders.

Heavy bulls gained selling for 310c to 330c and light weight bulls returned 342c to 504c/kg.

A cow and calf unit sold for \$2940 .
