



MT BARKER CATTLE SALE 4/8/22

Yarding 205 head – down 101

Numbers were down for a small yarding of mixed quality cattle offered at Mt Barker. Weaner steers sold to 622c, while heavy cows lost last week's gain to top at 240c/kg.

Weaner steers sold from 526c to 622c while weaner heifers returned 356c to 518c depending on quality. Yearling steers made 378c to 458c, while yearling heifers gained selling from 380c up to 416c/kg.

Grown steers made 378c for the heavier weights to processors and from 390c to 466c to feeder buyers while grown heifers sold from 270c to 380c/kg.

Heavy prime cows made 224c up to 240c while store cows sold from 162c to 220c/kg.

One heavy bull offered sold for 240c and a light weight weaner bull returned 366c/kg.
