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Your Frequently Asked Questions

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APPLICATION PROCESS

How do I apply for one of Nutrien Ag Solutions' Graduate Programs?

Head to our careers page, search graduate program, select the relevant program, and hit apply - www.nutrienagsolutions.com.au/careers. Applications open on the 17th of April 2023. You can also apply by heading to our Grad Australia page and selecting jobs and opportunities https:// gradaustralia.com.au/graduate-employers/nutrienag-solutions.

I graduated 3 years ago— can I apply?

Yes, you can apply. We welcome applications from those that have graduated no longer than 3 years ago and are due to graduate prior to the commencement date in February 2024.

When do applications close for the 2024 **Program?**

Applications will close on the 15th of May 2023.

Who can apply?

For our 2024 Graduate Program, we are seeking applications from those that have completed a minimum of a Diploma of Agriculture for our

Agronomy & Agribusiness streams, and a minimum of • Due diligence checks including a minimum an undergraduate for our corporate streams in Human Resources, Marketing, Communications, IT, or anv other business-related Finance undergraduate degree.

What working rights do I need to have?

To be considered for the Graduate Program, you must have full working rights within Australia. This may be Australian or New Zealand Citizenship or Permanent Residency status.

As an applicant, what can I expectation from the selection Process?

All candidates are reviewed without bias and will be assessed fairly against the role and its criteria without discrimination. As part of the process, you will undergo a few different processes including:

- Online application (CV, academic transcript, and cover letter are all essential)
- Virtual interview with Talent Team
- Virtual or Face to Face interview with Hiring Manager/s which may include behavioural, openended, and situational interview questions

- of 2 reference checks (character or professional), VEVO (visa) check, if applicable, background & police checks and a pre-employment medical
- Verbal offers for successful candidates

When will I hear back about my application?

You will receive a confirmation email within 24 hours of submitting your application to confirm your application has successfully been entered into our system. While we screen applications as they are submitted, applications are open for 5 weeks from 17th April to 15th May so kindly please give us some time throughout this period to make contact with you regarding the outcome of your application. Most applications are processed and you are notified of the outcome within 2-3 weeks, however the whole process can take up to 8 weeks from application to verbal offer. We aim to keep you informed of your progress throughout the assessment stages. Due to the volume of applications, we are unable to respond individually to requests for status updates.

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I am an existing employee/intern at Nutrien Ag Solutions, do I still need to apply for the program?

We must still apply through our careers page. In line with our recruitment ϑ selection policy, you must also notify your current line manager your intentions of applying before doing so.

What happens if I am not successful?

A member of the Talent Attraction team will inform you either written or verbally as to the outcome of your application. Whilst we may not be able to offer you a position in the program, we may consider you for other roles and encourage you to continue to apply for other opportunities with us.

Can I apply if I have work experience?

Our Graduate Programs are aimed at candidates with no more than 2 years' relevant post graduate experience. If you have more than 2 years post graduate experience within the industry you will find more appropriate jobs on ours career site www.nutrienagsolutions.com.au/careers.


What do I need to attach to my application?

Along with an updated resume, you will need to include a cover letter outlining your interest in agriculture and Nutrien Ag Solutions as well as how you relate to our company values of safety, inclusion, integrity and results (no longer than one page). You will also need to attach a copy of your academic transcript or a snapshot of your results if you do not have a copy of your transcript.

Can I apply for more than one Graduate Program advertisement at a time?

Yes, you may apply for multiple opportunities that you feel are a match to your skills, experience and/or qualifications. Please ensure you are prepared to discuss with the Talent Attraction team your preference as well as whether you are mobile as some roles will require you to have geographic mobility.





Create your candidate profile and upload your resume, cover letter & academic results.

A member of the Talent Attraction team will review all applicants against the criteria. They will then conduct a virtual interview with selected* candidates. Approx 30 mins. This is the time to get to know each other. This can be in person or virtually and will be conducted by a stakeholder/s relevant to your discipline. Approx 1 hour.

Depending on the role, you may be required to complete background checks, VEVO (visa) checks, reference checks and/or medical. Congratulations you have made it to the end of the recruitment process, and we will be presenting you with a job offer to commence officially in February.

*Only those that have been shortlisted for a 1st interview will be contacted verbally. All other applicants will be notified via email about the outcome of their application.



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YOUR EMPLOYMENT

What happens after I accept a placement in the program?

Our Graduate Program commences in February 2024; however, you will be invited to engage in our pre-onboarding activities before your employment commences next year. This will involve meeting your buddy and direct line manager, meeting other graduates, meeting your mentors, and attending team events as appropriate such as trivia and participating in any interesting webinars held by Nutrien Ag Solutions. By the time the program commences in February, you will have developed relationships and a network as well as having a solid understanding of the business you are joining.

When will I start working?

Our program commences in February 2024.

Is there an opportunity to work casually or part-time prior to the commencement of the program?

We often have several casual opportunities available, and, in some instances, we may engage

you for casual work prior to the commencement of the program. During the recruitment and selection process, we will ask you if you are interested in any pre-start work and will do our best to accomodate this - the sooner the better!

Our Graduate Program offers you a permanent position within a business group or branch. Those that form part of the Graduate Agronomy program in Victoria rotate 2 times across the 24-month period. Excitingly, our HR & Communications Graduate will rotate across the two disciplines. For all other locations and streams, while we don't offer a formal rotation program across the business, some business groups run these within their sections at their own discretion.

Can I apply if I am a penultimate student?

While we are ideally looking at final year students for the Graduate program if you are a penultimate year student and want to apply for an internship you can. Email your CV to
