

MT BARKER TRADE CATTLE SALE 16/11/2023

Numbers were down for a total yarding of 1138 good quality cattle with weaner calves again dominating the numbers. A run of excellent quality weaner calves saw prices lift with heavy weaner steers selling to 274c and heifers to 188c/kg. All other categories followed the trend with processor demand for prime lines while plain store pens were harder to move. Heavy cows were up 10c and bulls gained 20c/kg.

Light weight weaner steers sold to 286c while the heavier weights made from 200c to 274c/kg. Weaner heifers made the biggest gain returning 100c to 188c/kg. Yearling steers sold from 150c to 250c remaining firm and yearling heifers were up selling from 120c to 184c/kg.

Grown steers gained returning 170c to 186c /kg.

Heavy cows were up selling from 112c to 140c while store cows returned 70c to 90c /kg. Heavy bulls sold from 112c to 152c while lighter weights made 124c to 152c/kg.
