Mutrien Livestock yarded 800 of 1315 weaners at Boyanup today. The heavy angus steer offering above 400kg was very good quality selling from 250 to 272c/kg. Angus steers in the 300 to 400kg range eased by 5 to 15c/kg on last weeks values. The coluored steers of all classess softened by 5 to 10c/kg. Angus heifers dropped by 30 to 40c/kg on last weeks values with the absence of the live exporters. The coloured heifers also dropped 5 to 10c/kg. In general terms the market reduced in value with a number of lot feeders having filled their requirements, coupled with live shippers also having filled their orders.
