Market Comment:

Agents yarded 10941 sheep and lambs with Nutrien yarding 3733 of these. Heavy lambs sold \$110-\$135, trade lamb \$90-\$110. Light & Store xb lambs \$50-\$80 while merino drafts \$20-\$48. Immature and poor lambs hard to sell. Ewe mutton remained equal with heavy mutton \$35-\$56 with graziers pushing younger drafts of dorper ewes. Trade weight mutton, regardless of breed, \$20-\$35 while boners sold \$10-\$18 poor conditioned sheep \$1-\$3. Merino Hoggets sold \$19-\$35 while dorper ewe hoggets sold to top \$56. Heavy Rams \$20-\$30 and lighter rams \$2-\$15
