Market Comment:

Nutrien reports a larger yarding of 8332 sheep and lambs at Katanning on the 07.02.2024. Once again most lines of crossbred lambs and ewe mutton lacked weight and condition with light hoggets and mutton proving hard to sell. Heavy crossbred lambs sold from \$120 - \$135 with most sales from \$65 - \$90. Light stores sold from \$40 - \$60. Ewe mutton remained firm with better sales from \$30 - \$40 with most sales selling from \$20 - \$30. Light boning ewes sold from \$2 - \$15. Merino hoggets proved hard to sell, selling from \$5 - \$20. Rams sold from \$10 - \$20.
