

MT BARKER TRADE SALE 2 / 5 / 2024

Numbers were up for a total yarding of 1404 head of very mixed quality cattle. Feeder buyers were chasing weights paying to 328c for steer weaners and up to 288c for heavy weight heifers. Trade steers sold to 250c while quality heifers made up to 260c/kg. Heavy cows remained firm while heavy bulls regained last fortnights fall.

Weaner steers sold from 134c to 328c, and heifers made from 76c to 288c/kg. Yearling steers returned 160c to 316c while heifers sold from 180c to 280c/kg.

Grown steers sold to 250c while grown heifers weighing under 540kg made from 168c to 260c while heavier weights returned 210c to 226c/kg.

Heavy cows sold from 150c to 194c while store cows continued to rise selling from 115c to 174c /kg. Heavy bulls made from 140c to 198c and medium weights gained selling from 150c to 200c/kg.
