



MT BARKER TRADE SALE 09/05/2024

Numbers eased for a mixed quality yarding of 1139 head of cattle. Young cattle were presented in mainly store condition reflecting the season. Young steers to feedlotters gained 10c selling to 332c while heifers eased on last week's gain selling to 250c /kg. Trade weight heifers remained firm at 258c/kg.

Weaner steers sold from 150c to 332c, and heifers made from 90c to 250c/kg. Yearling steers returned 230c to 310c while heifers sold from 124c to 250c/kg.

Grown heifers weighing under 540kg made from 210c to 258c while heavier weights returned 190c to 220c/kg.

Heavy cows sold from 150c to 196c while store cows eased on quality selling from 100c to 152c /kg. Heavy bulls gained returning 178c to 192c and medium weights eased selling from 150c to 160c/kg.
