Market Comment

Today's Muchea agents yarded and sold 9421 sheep and lambs. Heavy lambs 25kg dressed \$180-\$198, trade lambs saw stronger competition \$160-\$181.

Airfreight lambs \$130-\$159 while store buyers were strong on lambs over 35kg live selling \$80-\$131 plain lambs and immature \$60-\$80.

Heavy mutton sold strongly \$90-\$120 trade mutton \$70-\$92 while boning grade ewes were keenly sort after \$45-\$68.

Hoggets sold strongly topping out \$137 while plainer drafts \$70-\$90.

Poor and light hoggets \$10-\$50 wethers followed similar values to ewe mutton. Topping out at \$137. Rams sold for \$20-\$40.
