Market Report

Nutrien Livestock reports 1089 cattle for the first of the March store sale fixtures at Boyanup Saleyards. The overall quality of the yarding was mixed, in particular the steer portion of the yarding. The general tone of the market reflected this. Steers that displayed better confirmation were sought after by grass and lot fatteners while the light and plain cattle sold to a subdued gallery of graziers and backgrounders.

Beef heifers sold to stronger competition than that of the steers offering. The market sold firmly in comparison to past markets and competition from lot feeders and grass fatteners realised a top of 288c/kg.

A Quality offering of first cross steers was met with strong competition, with those suitable to feed selling to 300c/kg. Friesian steers gained 10-20c/kg for all weight classes, realising a top of 224c/kg.
