Nutrien Livestockyarded 33 of a total of 74 cattle at Boyanup Saleyards this week. The smaller than usual yarding is a sign that the hustle & bustle of the selling season is drawing to an end in the Southwest. The quality of the offering was mixed across all classes. Heavy cows in short supply sold 10-15c/kg higher reaching 336c/kg. Heavy bulls made 298c/kg and heavy yearling steers realised 380c/kg. A classy pen of heavy yearling heifers from a local stud breeder topped the market at 390c/kg. Lighter yearlings were in plain condition and leftovers from previous drafts, and these met with limited competition from restockers.
