

MIRIAM VALE MARKET REPORT

SALE DATE 24 APRIL 2026

402 head came to hand today at the Friday, 24th of April Miriam Vale Cattle Sale comprising of 217 Steers, 157 Heifers, 18 Cows, 3 Bulls and 6 Mickey Bulls.

The market remained strong considering there was a variance in quality presented at Miriam Vale this week.

Bulls sold to \$2140.

Cows sold to \$1820 to average \$1240. While the maximum price eased from the last sale due to size and condition of the cows, we saw a strengthening in the average price.

A substantial line of heavy feeder steers sold for \$1800.

Quality flatback steers sold to \$1100, to average \$900.

Brahman type weaner steers sold to \$1050, a significant strengthening from last fortnight due to quality and demand, to average \$800.

The heifer market remained strong with quality females being highly sought after. A pen of quality Brangus heifers sold to \$940, followed closely by a pen of Droughtmaster heifers at \$910. Heifers averaged \$670.
