Nutrien reports a smaller yarding of 10114 sheep and lambs at Katanning on the 03.06.2026. The yarding was comprised of crossbred and merino lambs with a small portion of ewe mutton. Heavy crossbred lambs sold firm with best sales from \$290 - \$322 with good trade feeder lambs selling from \$250 - \$280. Light store lambs sold to a \$10 increase realising \$140 - \$160. Ewe mutton sold strongly with best sales from \$240 - \$260. Trade to good boning ewes sold from \$170 - \$210 while light ewes sold from \$130 - \$170. Rams realised \$100 - \$170.
